1 What's New at a Glance in T7 Release 7.1

1.1 Xetra EnLight

T7 GUI offers a new Request for Quote service to negotiate on-exchange off-book transactions between a requester and one or several counterparties. Xetra EnLight will be available for all equities, ETFs and ETPs in XETR.

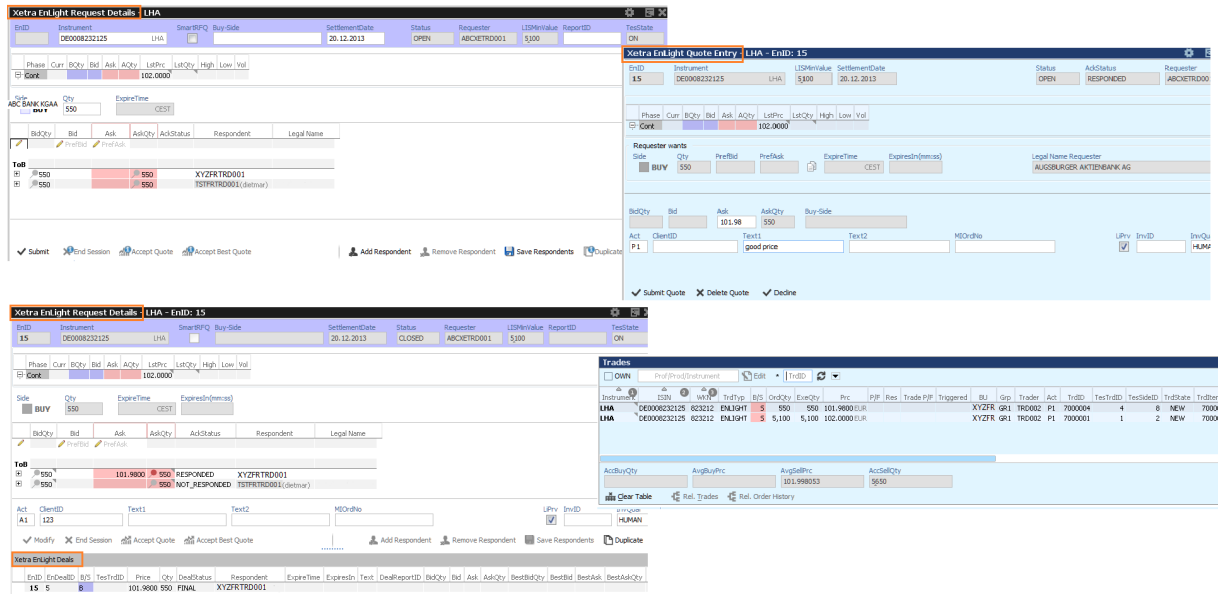


Fig. 1: Illustrative Overview of the new Xetra EnLight workflow

Embedded Straight-through-processing (STP) When a requester accepts a quote, it results automatically in a legally binding T7 TES Trade.

Smart RfQ - send an anonymous Negotiation Request to anonymous respondents. Requester and respondents are not known to each other during the life cycle of an Xetra EnLight Negotiation Event.

Complete Xetra EnLight description can be found in online help by pressing F1 on respective views.
